## CENTRAL FLORIDA ATHLETICS FEES

Each athlete will be charged a monthly fee. This will include monthly training and all necessities for the season: Registration, competition fees, choreography, music, competition bow, competition make up, sponsor shirt, and uniform.

Competition fees, membership fees, sponsorships and fundraising monies are non-refundable. There are no exceptions to this rule. If you start the program after June 1st, 2018 you will be responsible for all missed fees. Since the monthly fees amortize the many aspects that encompass competitive cheer, those fees must be collected.

All monthly payments must be paid by the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month except May; May costs will be due at the first due at practice.
